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Would you like to help the underprivileged communities in India? Would you like to help empower women? Do you enjoy helping to make a difference in the lives of others? Would you like to really live with a family in Rajasthan and have an unforgettable experience?

If so, Sambhali Trust is a small grassroots NGO in Rajasthan, India and is looking for volunteers to help teach women and girls from local communities in Jodhpur and Setrawa village, primarily to help with English, but it could also be with women's rights, health, nutrition, AIDS awareness or an arts topic such as dance, painting, design, any particular special interest that you have.

Sambhali Trust was formed 3 years ago and has 2 main projects where volunteers can get involved:

- **Jodhpur Empowerment project** – women and girls of 15-22 years are taught English (through foreign volunteers), Hindi and a variety of sewing techniques as well as cultural activities and workshops. The 2 year course hopes to raise awareness in health and educational topics as well as vocational training.
- **Setrawa village project** – A centre was established to enable the young children between 6-12 years old to have a better standard of English, as well as having a sewing class and drop-in centre for the women of the village.
